# Here Come The New Varieties

While numerous aspects have been added to Pack Trials throughout the years, from marketing programs to innovative displays, the real focus of the event is still on the varieties. Here is a sampling of the new plants we saw at the 2007 California Pack Trials.

### Alyssum

Allure series. The new alyssum Allure series is very uniform with great color selection for consumers, especially with its pastel mix. The plants are compact with good basal branching. Varieties are grown from seed that is film coated with a fungicide. The series is genetically compact and early flowering, actually slightly earlier flowering than other series currently on the market. The pastel formula mix caught our eye because of the pleasing combination of so many light colors. Allure comes in seven separate colors and a mix. As far as the culture goes, Allure is the same as Easter Bonnet and Wonderland. Kieft Seeds Holland. www.kieftseeds.com

### Angelonia

'Angelface Dark Violet'. When it came to this new variety, there was quite a controversy going on with our group at Proven Winners. The commotion was all about whether men or women liked this new, interesting variety. Overall, Proven Winners said that women liked the plant while men didn't (of those coming through the trials).

This angelonia's color is a standout in the industry: 'Angelface Dark Violet' has the darkest blooms in the series, with velvety purple flowers. It is extremely compact with smaller flowers because the dark blooms and foliage absorb heat. Very well branched, this variety can be easily grown in small containers. It will reach up to 2 ft. in the landscape and is similar in habit to 'Angelface Wedgewood Blue'. Dark Violet was bred not to fade and should hold its color spring through summer. #### Bacopa

'Abunda Colossal Lavender'. Within the past few years, bacopa has really been making its way into the industry as a major crop, especially the larger-flowered kind. However, many of those varieties were mostly white. Ball FloraPlant introduced 'Abunda Colossal Lavender', which produces extremely large flowers with a nice lavender color.

This plant has a lot of flower power from spring through autumn, which is enhanced by its slightly more upright habit; this bacopa is not as prostrate or trailing. Abunda varieties have good basal branching and heat tolerance. Lavender works well in 4½-inch containers and 1-qt. programs. The slightly more upright habit of Abunda Colossal varieties is more responsive to Cycocel (chlormequat chloride) than other bacopas and allows for pot-tight production with no tangling. ### Begonia


**'Bellfire'.** When Selecta introduced begonia 'Bonfire' last year, it was quite a hit among growers. Now the company has added begonia 'Bellfire' to the mix to make it even more exciting in the begonia world.

This new variety has dark foliage with red on the bottom of the leaves and cerise-red flowers. 'Bellfire' grows more upright and is more vigorous than 'Bonfire', but both perform great for consumers. *Begonia boliviensis* are not easy for growers during winter as they could go dormant if grown too cold or under short days (it is a tuberous begonia). #### Calibrachoa

Aloha series. Calibrachoa has been a great new addition to the industry within the past five plus years. The calibrachoa Aloha series has been bred for a semi-upright habit, which works well in mixed container gardening. However, one of the most exciting parts of the new series is the point-of-purchase material that goes with it and the vibrant blue containers.

Aloha varieties also have very large flowers with bright, clean colors over a large color range. Each calibrachoa in the series was selected heavily

### **Calla Lilv**

'Ruby Sensation'. This year, Golden State Bulb Growers announced it was going to make a large push for its callas at retail. The company plans to work closer with retailers to let them know that callas can be used for more than just wedding bouquets. The new calla 'Ruby Sensation' is right on track to make that happen.

It has dark- to medium-pink flowers with a leathery texture. This plant is very floriferous and long lasting; it is very versatile and can be grown in any size pot as well as in some really nice combination plantings. #### Coleus

'Chocolate Mint'. In a trendy combination of colors that is sure to be a hit with consumers, coleus 'Chocolate Mint' features rich, chocolate-colored leaves edged with mint green. Again, you must be thinking "another coleus?" but this is a really modern color combination for this plant. The green accenting on the edges actually looks like each midsize leaf was hand-stitched with vibrant color.

### **Dianthus**

'Fandango Crimson' has frilly petals and semidouble blooms on tall plants that reach 16-18 inches in the garden. This series is excellent for large container programs; strong branching quickly fills pots. It is Hardy to Zone 9. This dianthus is Fusarium and heat tolerant. Total crop time for Fandango is 16-19 weeks. 

### **Fuchsia**

**Fuchsia push.** For the 2008 spring season, Ball FloraPlant added 14 commercially available fuchsia varieties to its lineup, including both trailing and upright varieties. The availability of these fuschia varieties helps round out Ball's product offerings to growers and makes them more of the one-stop shop that the company aims to be. It is interesting to see the direction that FloraPlant is moving when it comes to its plant line. Adding the fuchsia line was a very interesting move for the vegetative company.

### Gazania

**Gazania Sunbathers series.** When walking through the gardens of Ecke Ranch, the first thing that we were drawn to was the gazania SunBathers series. The plants were so vibrant and colorful that it looked like the sun setting in the west. In fact, the varieties in this series were named after famous beaches, such as Gold Coast and Sunset (more colors are on the way).

With breeding done in Australia, the SunBathers series can be grown cold but takes heat. The series' best feature is the showy, bright flowers that lack a dark eye. The flowers will not close completely at night or on cloudy days like seed gazania. The blooms have a semi-double form. Varieties in this series are best suited for 4-inch, 6-inch and 1-gal. containers. Typical crop timing is 13-17 weeks including time in propagation. Ecke Ranch. www.ecke.com

### Geranium

**Belmonte series.** For the past several years, Schwartz Nursery has not really had any new introductions to the market; however, this year was different. It is heat and humidity tolerant and does well in a moist, well-drained soil. There should be no need for growth regulators, but pinch 1-2 times for branching and good shape. It is bred to be easy to root, with a rooting time of 3-4 weeks. Fertilize with 150- to 200-ppm nitrogen. Jaldety Plant Propagation Nursery. www.jaldety.com

### **Jamesbrittenia**

**'Britney Grand Pink' and 'Britney Grand Red'.** Jamesbrittenia varieties are becoming the modernday bacopas that offer more flower color variety and interest. 'Britney Grand Pink' and 'Britney Grand Red' have large flowers with yellow eyes. Grand Pink has salmon-pink blooms accented with a purple halo, while Grand Red features dark-red flowers surrounded by a Bordeaux halo.

The colors are unique introductions not easily found in other bacopa cultivars. Both plants are



Growers should use 4- to 6-inch pots with this vigorous variety. Growers can also play around with it and see what kinds of holiday interest it can bring by potting it up in Christmas holiday containers. Fides North America. www.fidesnorthamerica.com

### Lavender

**Lavender push.** Who doesn't love the smell of lavender? Not many say they don't, hence the reason Hishtil has been adding new lavenders to its mix for the last several years, and this year has some nice additions. A hummingbird and butterfly attractant, this pentas has an interesting "selfcleaning" flower structure that ensures continuous flowering throughout the summer. Flower clusters are more open and display nicely above the foliage. 'Northern Lights Lavender' has a reduced pH sensitivity and will take pH down to 6.2 (many pentas require at least a 6.5 pH). ### **Petunia**

Mini-Me series. Not only is this series exciting to Austin Powers fans all over the world, but it is

exciting to petunia and calibrachoa fans as well. The new petunia Mini-Me series from Cohen caught our attention for a number of reasons. First, the varieties offer pretty small flowers. However, while the small blooms may resemble calibrachoa flowers, Mini-Me petunias are not cross bred and contain only petunia genetics, meaning you have a calibrachoa-looking flower without the crazy habit and lack of heat tolerance.

The Mini-Me series flowers earlier than calibrachoa and has no pH or water sensitivity. However, the series is not uniform, and flower size varies among the varieties. Plants in the series are very compact and half hanging with small green leaves that compliment the small flowers. Cohen Propagation Nurseries. www.cohennur.co.il

Opera Supreme series. The new petunia Opera Supreme series from American Takii has an extremely low, spreading habit. One plant will easily spread to a 4 ft. diameter. Very floriferous, the eight varieties in the series each produce an abundance of flowers over the entire plant, including the center. The flowers are medium sized and the internodes are short compared to other trailing petunia varieties. This series exhibits less day-length sensitivity than other trailing-type petunias; the varieties require a minimum of 11½ hours to induce flowering. 

great new series, but it is a great case in point that marketing really makes a difference.

The entire line is all about high-voltage color for small spaces. The petite flowers measure 1½-2 inches. The series was bred to bloom in a tight, consistent 4- to 6-day window. Shock Wave petunias are generally 3-5 days earlier than Easy Wave varieties. Shock Wave and Easy Wave varieties can be grown side by side with no changes in culture. #### Salvia

**Cathedral series.** One of the really interesting things about the new salvia Cathedral series is that it is 4-6 weeks earlier than seed. Of the three colors in the series, Sky Blue is most unique.
